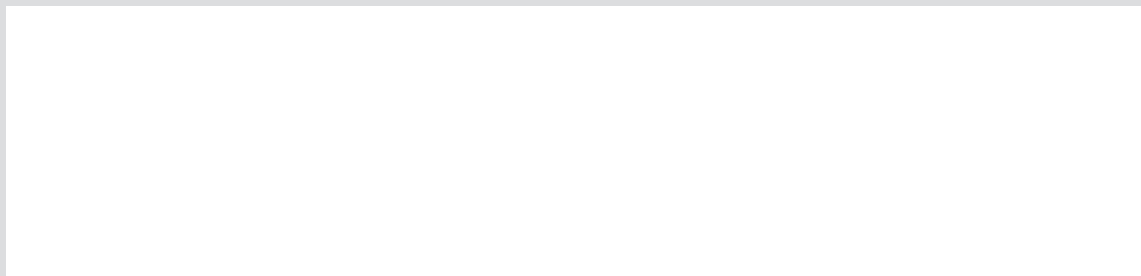

# RESULTS:

**VO spearheaded DC's first economic development project in twenty years – the Home Depot, Giant, Bank of America Shopping Center Complex in Ward 5.** Thereafter, VO brought COSTCO, Lowes, Yes! Organic, Union Market, Monroe & Michigan Avenue NE development and much more to fruition in Ward 5.

**VO led the fight for school and recreation center modernization in Ward 5 –** demanding it- and got it done – including the reopening and renovation of McKinley Tech as McKinley Technology High School and the renovation of Noyes Elementary School; and the rebuilding and renovation of Turkey Thicket, North Michigan Park and Brentwood recreation centers.

**VO pushed through improved school curriculums -** for DC's 3rd and 8th grade students and enacted legislation mandating our children receive books for their core subjects by the second week of each new school year and certification thereof within 30 days.

**VO's legislation placed a moratorium on strip clubs in Ward 5 –** and a cap on the number of medical marijuana cultivation centers and medical marijuana dispensaries that can be placed in any Ward.

**VO's legislation established the \$15.00 per hour minimum wage in DC –** and 5 days of sick leave pay for tipped wage workers.

**VO secured DCTV headquarters relocating to Ward 5's Brooks Mansion and funding for the renovations thereof –** and prevented METRO from using the location for a jail.

**VO's 2005 legislation established the only public holiday in Washington, DC history –** April 16th, the District of Columbia Emancipation Day.

**VO helped DC turn a fiscal year 1999 -** \$518 million deficit into a \$1.6 billion surplus reserve by fiscal year 2007.

**VO was the 7th vote to bring baseball back to DC –** and the building of Nationals Stadium.

**VO invested more in DC Small Businesses –** increasing DC Certified Business Enterprises contract opportunities from \$98 million in 2001 to \$567 million in 2006. VO organized the "Where Is The One Billion Dollars" contracting opportunities for DC businesses that resulted in DC businesses receiving contract opportunities exceeding One Billion Dollars today!

**VO secured DC jobs for DC residents –** by calling for the enforcement of the First Source Program which requires that at least 51% of new hires on DC-funded projects must be DC residents. VO's signature program "**Hire One, Save One**" and Ward 5 job fairs were extremely successful.
